# Small Business Rebate Program

Do you have a business with 0-50 full-time employees or equivalent? If so, you can receive up to \$500 to help your business to be smarter and safer.











**How will** the rebate help my business?

## Smarter businesses are more competitive

The small business rebate gives money back to small business owners who adopt a solution to a safety problem in their workplace. Investing in safety solutions helps you:

- prevent incidents, illnesses and costs to your business
- build safety skills for you and your staff
- access free safety advice
- demonstrate to your community that you are serious about workplace health and safety.

# What is covered?

### Reduce your highest risks

The rebates aim to reduce the highest potential costs and risks to your business.

You can receive a rebate on a full cost basis up to a maximum \$500 towards the cost of purchasing and installing eligible safety equipment that addresses:

- manual tasks
- chemicals and dangerous goods
- injuries from moving objects.

- slips, trips and falls
- hazardous noise

Eligible rebate items are indicated on pages 2 and 3 of this application form. The rebate item must be purchased after you have attended an eligible safety activity (see Step 1 below).

Note: rebates do not cover GST, freight or insurance.

# What do I need to do?

### To apply for a rebate

You must be a small business owner in NSW, with 0-50 full-time employees (or equivalent).

You can claim for more than one safety solution at the same time but can only apply for the rebate once. Applications must be lodged within six months of the date of an eligible WorkCover safety workshop, live webinar, program, event or advisory visit attendance.

# Step 1 – Attend

First, attend an eligible WorkCover safety workshop, live webinar, program, event conducted by WorkCover, or have an advisory visit from a WorkCover officer.

# Step 2 – Solution

Select and implement a safety solution from the list on pages 2 and 3 and get a \*paid tax invoice, receipt or proof of purchase. The item you would like to purchase must be purchased after you attend an eligible safety workcover.nsw.gov.au WorkCover event, as outlined in

# Step 3 – Claim

Claim up to a \$500 rebate by completing and signing page 5 of the application form.

- GST, freight and insurance costs. Activities deemed as training, safety promotion or advertising, computer or software systems, repairs, maintenance, general business or administration signage, tools and equipment, salaries or amenities, housekeeping or cleaning, personal protection equipment, temperature control equipment, silos, licensing, certification, safety investigations, infringement activities, penalties or fees, premiums, registers, diagnostic, testing or auditing services (including consultants), first-aid, emergency programs, general alarm systems, return-to-work, rehabilitation, counselling or vaccination programs or equipment, or operational items.
- The design or manufacturing of new items, or purchase of second-hand items.

### Remember

The rebate helps you to manage safety better and achieve best practice. It does not relieve you of your obligations to comply with safety laws.

When controlling hazards in the workplace do the following:

- 1. **Eliminate** the hazard if practical to do so.
- 2. If it's not practical to eliminate the hazard, **substitute** it with a lesser risk eg change equipment or materials.
- 3. **Isolate** the hazard eg sound proof enclosure.
- 4. Use **engineering** control eg design in safety.
- 5. Use administrative controls eg safety signage.
- 6. Use personal protective equipment (PPE) eg wear safety hearing protection equipment.

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# SPECIAL PROMOTION/WEBINAR

WorkCover may also provide additional assistance to businesses to address specific high risks. As part of this special assistance, WorkCover may include additional safety solution items, financial support and/or amend the criteria for a limited time to qualify for a small business rebate.

WorkCover also provides a range of eligible safety activities to help small businesses build their safety knowledge and skills, such as live webinars, workshops, field safety days, and advisory visits. Webinars allow you to participate in online safety presentations from your own workplace.

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# **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

The following terms and conditions apply to the WorkCover NSW Small Business Rebate Program. Please read them carefully before signing this form.

- 1. Application for the Small Business Rebate Program
  - 1.1 To be eligible for the Program, you must fulfil the following criteria.
    - 1.1.1 Be an owner of a business operating in NSW with 0–50 full-time employees (or equivalent). Eligible small businesses (including sole traders) must come within the scope of the WHS legislation in NSW and be currently conducting a commercial business that is producing or providing goods and/or services in NSW. Businesses outside this scope are ineligible to apply eg investment trusts, managed funds, strata title schemes, subsidiaries of larger businesses, voluntary associations. Please contact us on 13 10 50 if you are unsure of whether your business would be eligible.
    - 1.1.2 Attend an eligible WorkCover safety workshop, live webinar, program, event conducted by WorkCover or have an advisory visit by a WorkCover officer.
    - 1.1.3 Implement an eligible safety solution outlined on pages 2 and 3 of this form.
    - 1.1.4 Complete and sign the Small Business Rebate application form (above).
    - 1.1.5 Send a copy of your paid invoice(s), receipt(s) or proof of purchase and required documentation with this completed application form to WorkCover. Invoice(s) and receipt(s) need to be purchased from a registered business and state the business/contractor's name, address, ABN/ACN/BRN number, payment date, description and cost of product or work undertaken. Applications must be lodged within six (6) months of the date of the WorkCover safety workshop, live webinar, program, event or advisory visit attendance.

### 2. Eligibility for a rebate

- 2.1 Eligible rebate solutions must be existing manufactured safety items that meet all relevant standards, approvals, and legislative requirements and are available for purchase by small businesses at commercial outlets eg competitive existing commercial products. Rebates will not cover the design or manufacturing of new items, purchase of second-hand items, service repairs or maintenance. Rebates will not subsidise retrospective improvements made before attending a current WorkCover safety workshop, live webinar, program, event, or advisory visit. The rebate program does not endorse or promote any individual safety product or service, or provide an unfair competitive advantage to any commercial safety item, product or service.
- 2.2 Items eligible for the rebate must be installed by a licensed tradesperson where required by law eg installation of electrical items must be carried out by a licensed electrical contractor, and a *Certificate of Compliance Electrical Work* must be provided.
- 2.3 Rebate solutions do not cover products or equipment for domestic, recreational or social activities. Items for home-based businesses that may be deemed as being used for domestic/household purposes or contributing to the value of residential assets are not included. A home-based business is deemed to be a business whose primary office or place of work is in the owner's residential home.
- 2.4 The rebate is not available for solutions that have already received a rebate from another WorkCover safety initiative or rebate.

  Nor is it available to government agencies, or for businesses claiming on behalf of another business eg agents or consultants lodging applications on behalf of their clients.
- 2.5 You can claim for more than one safety solution at the same time (up to \$500 full cost) but can only apply for the small business rebate once, irrespective of the number, name, registration or NSW location of individual businesses/ABNs that you own. The maximum eligible one-off small business rebate is \$500 total per business.
- 2.6 You can apply for different rebate programs ie apply for separate items under separate WorkCover rebate programs, as or where these become available but you must meet the terms and conditions of each respective program.
- 2.7 Activities listed under 'Excluded items' on page 2, including GST, freight and insurance costs, do not quality for the rebate.

### 3. Refund of a rebate

- 3.1 As part of providing this rebate, WorkCover reserves the right to confirm that the rebate solution is effective and durable.
- 3.2 Applicants may be required to repay the rebate if any of these terms and conditions are found to have been breached.

#### Feedback and publicity

4.1 WorkCover may contact participants for feedback on the Small Business Rebate and may publicise their business's involvement in the Program with their prior approval.

#### 5. Program changes

5.1 WorkCover reserves the right to exercise its discretion to change any or all of the terms and conditions of the program or to cancel the program at any time.

### 6. Liability

- 6.1 The applicant acknowledges and agrees that as far as the law permits, WorkCover (and its successors) accepts no liability in respect to any claim, cause of action or loss or damage arising out of, or in relation to, an improvement that is the subject of this funding assistance.
- 6.2 The applicant agrees that they release WorkCover from any claim or liability arising out of, or in relation to, the rebate that is the subject of the registration or rebate application, to the extent that claim or liability is not caused by WorkCover's negligence or breach of this application or any other term implied by law.

#### 7. Privacy Notice

- 7.1 WorkCover collects and manages the personal information you provide in accordance with the *Privacy and Personal Information Protection Act 1998*. WorkCover collects this information to determine whether your application is eligible for a rebate, to provide our services to you, to improve the quality of our services, and to provide you with information about other services we offer. Your personal information may be provided to the Australian Government as a matter of course to ensure that the total of government benefits you receive does not exceed the total cost of your installed safety solution. Failure to provide the information may result in us not being able to process your application form.
- 7.2 You have the right to access and correct any of your personal information at any time, once we have collected it. To access or amend your personal information relating to your rebate application, applications should be made in writing to the Privacy Contact Officer, WorkCover Head Office, Locked Bag 2906, Lisarow, NSW 2252.
